

Project Reset

Project Reset is a diversion program for eligible participants who have been arrested for the first time for low level misdemeanors in Brooklyn, Bronx, or Harlem.

Program Details:

Eligible participants who attend one of our workshops will have the opportunity to receive a decline to prosecute letter from the District Attorney's office. Once participants have received their decline to prosecute letter, they do not have to appear in court.

What we offer:

- A Restorative Justice circle to reflect on misdemeanors and ways to give back to their community.
- 2-3 hours of **Community Building** projects with local partners in the Harlem community.
- 2 hours of Narcan Training. After completion, participants are certified as first responders to Opioid Overdose.
- 3 hours of Social Resilience Model training. After completion, participants will have the tools to respond to stressful situations.

Project Reset also provides case management, and internal and external referrals for participants.

Eligible Participants:

Eligible participants have been arrested for low-level, first time misdemeanors.
